Directions to Willow Springs

Drive to Rosamond on Hwy 14:

- Head west on Rosamond Blvd – go 6.8 miles
- Turn right on 90th Street West – go 0.7 miles
- Turn left onto Truman Road – go 0.4 miles
- Turn right onto Manly Road – go 0.3 miles

Look for the Saloon on the left-hand side of the road. It's about 13 miles from the intersection of Hwy 14. and Rosamond Blvd.



Remember- this is not the racetrack of the same name, the community is farther west.
